Traffic Advisory: Chickatawbut Road & Wampatuck Road Closures in Blue Hills

WHAT: The Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) will close

Chickatawbut and Wampatuck roads in the Blue Hills Reservation to allow the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority (MWRA) to complete necessary

work on the Blue Hills Dam Masonry and Spillway repairs.

Chickatawbut and Wampatuck Roads will be closed to all traffic starting Sunday, evening, November 18 through Monday afternoon, November 19, and again Monday evening, November 26 into Tuesday afternoon, November 27. Signs will be posted to alert area residents and drivers of the closures.
