Quarterly Ambient Monitoring Results and Contingency Plan Reporting

Dear Mr. Borci and Ms. Coniaris:

In fulfillment of Part I.7.c.iv of the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority's ("MWRA") Deer Island Wastewater Treatment Plant permit, "The results of all monitoring required by the ambient monitoring plan or the eutrophication model shall be reported to EPA, MADEP, OMSAP and NMFS, on a quarterly basis," I am pleased to submit MWRA's quarterly report on ambient monitoring results. These reports are also available on MWRA's website at https://www.mwra.com/harbor/html/bhrecov.htm.

MWRA is submitting five reports this quarter. The first and second summarize water column and benthic monitoring results for 2022, respectively. The third is on MWRA's continuous monitoring in Massachusetts Bay, focusing on chlorophyll measurements. The fourth reports on the results from the 2023 flounder monitoring. The last is MWRA's Contingency Plan Report for the fourth quarter of 2023 Ambient Monitoring.

As has been observed since outfall startup in September 2000, findings in these reports continue to indicate that the Deer Island Treatment Plant outfall discharge is not adversely impacting the environment.
