



MWRA Hazardous Tree Removal Hultman Aqueduct – Framingham, MA

Dear Resident,

The Massachusetts Water Resources Authority (MWRA) is commencing work to removal hazardous trees along the Hultman Aqueduct. As you may know, hazardous trees can pose a significant threat to public safety, personal property, and subsurface infrastructure, such as the aqueduct.

Work will commence on the Hultman Aqueduct between Millwood Street and Grove Street in the City of Framingham. Hours of work operations will be between 7:00AM and 3:00PM; however, work is expected to occur intermittently as weather conditions, staff schedules, and other circumstances permit. Please see below of a general map of the work area.
