System share for each Chicopee Valley Aqueduct (CVA) community is each CVA community's share of total MWRA water supplied to the CVA system. Water assessments for revenue communities are calculated by allocating the total annual water rate revenue requirement based on each community's share of flow. Water assessments for CVA communities are calculated by allocating the annual CVA rate revenue requirement based on each CVA community's share of CVA flow.

²) Lexington supplies Bedford with partial MWRA water service.

³) The Town of Clinton receives up to 800 million gallons of water per year free of charge and is charged a flat wholesale rate per million gallons for water in excess of 800 million gallons per year.

⁴) Other Revenue Customers: D.C.R. (Parks & Pools), DCR Blue Hills Ski Area, Stone Zoo, Deer Island WWTP, and the Town of Wayland emergency use.

⁵) Other Revenue Customers are charged a wholesale rate per million gallons of water supplied.

⁶) This report includes only water supplied for which revenue is collected in accordance with existing water agreements. It does not include water utilized for system maintenance, or water provided to the McLaughlin Fish Hatchery.
