- DCR-DWSP road salt reduction video available on our website.
- Drought Persists in Several Regions of the Commonwealth. Cape Cod, Islands, and Northeast Continue to be Impacted
- Quabbin transfers to the Wachusett continue for water quality purposes.
- MWRA Reservoir drawdowns to kill invasive plants have been done at Chestnut Hill and Foss.
